Excerpts from Father Vasilios' recent sermon:

We must never be content to regard the miracles of Jesus as something which happened; we must regard them as something which happens. They are not isolated events in history; they are demonstrations of the always and forever operative power of Jesus Christ. And miracles are continuing especially right here in our Church at every Divine Liturgy. We offer to God the bread which has been prepared by a labor of love by the faithful and the wine which is made from the elements of the earth, real gifts of God who provides for our nourishment and all the good things we have. We offer them to Him through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ our Lord and He returns them to us as spiritual food: the Body and Blood of our Lord. Real food which leads to eternal life. Are we paying enough attention to this Gift of God by preparing ourselves to receive through repentance, prayer, and the reading and studying of the Scriptures? Receiving Communion should be the most important event in our lives...to receive our Lord so that we can become like Him and never die in His Kingdom.


So let us respond to the Lord's invitation frequently and fulfill our spiritual needs. The Divine Liturgy is not merely a prayer service but a meal, a banquet that the Lord invites us to.
